

"Portable virtual try-on for smart devices", a work of Dr. Sergio Escalera, Hugo Bertiche Argila and Dr. Meysam Madadi, has been one of the 101 recipients of the 2020 Amazon Research Awards (ARA). Congratulations!

In this project, the researchers from the #CVC and the Universitat de Barcelona, taking advantage of their successful previous experience with CLOTH3D, propose a feasible methodology to develop a scalable portable virtual try-on, dealing with the challenges of high frequency details (wrinkles) prediction and consistent cloth dynamics.

Thanks to this ARA, Sergio Escalera's group could spend \$100,000 in AWS credits, which allows them to use Amazon's high computing capacity in the cloud in order to develop their proposal.

The winners of the 2020 ARA represent 59 universities and 13 countries.

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Congratulations to the 101 recipients of the 2020 Amazon Research Awards, who represent 59 universities in 13 countries. Each award is intended to support the work of one to two graduate students or postdoctoral students for one year, under the supervision of a faculty member. Proposals were reviewed for the quality of their scientific content, their creativity, and their potential to impact both the research community, and society more generally.
